## How to Use

- Present the learner with the worksheet and clearly label each category.
- Provide modeling or prompting as needed (e.g., verbal, gestural, or physical prompts).
- Encourage independent responding and gradually fade prompts over time.
- Adapt the activity by adjusting the number of items when appropriate.

## Tips for Success

- Reinforce effort and correct responses with a high-five or “good sorting”!
- Keep the duration of the activities short, refrain from forcing a long duration.
