About This Resource

This set of tracing worksheets is designed to support the development of pre-writing and fine motor skills through structured and repetitive practice. These tracing worksheets help children build the foundational control needed for writing. These worksheets support the development of hand-eye coordination, pencil control, fine motor strength, and bilateral coordination.

What is Included

This resource includes a variety of tracing lines, such as:

- Horizontal Straight Lines
- Vertical Straight Lines
- Slanted Lines
- Curved Lines
- Zig-Zag Lines

These are arranged to support gradual skill progression from simple to more complex patterns.

How to Use

- Start with straight lines before moving to more complex patterns
- Model how to trace slowly and carefully
- Encourage proper pencil grip
- Provide guidance as needed and gradually fade support

Tips for Success

- Reinforce effort and completion with a high-five or “good tracing”!
- Keep the duration of the activities short.
- If pencil grip is a difficulty for your child’s fine motor skills, alternatively different tools (e.g., marker, crayon) can be utilized.
